The Planning Board has a special meeting scheduled for this evening to continue review of the Augusta Housing Authority's Maple Street multi-family housing proposal. You should have received copies of the packet that was distributed to the Planning Board.

On Wednesday, January 3, 2018, there will be a meeting of the Board of Zoning Appeals beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the Learning Gallery. Notices are included in your Council Packets.

On Thursday evening, January 4, Council will hold its first business meeting of 2018. As is traditional, there will be a reception – beginning at 6:30 pm - in honor of newly elected (or re-elected) members of the Council and School Board in lieu of a pre-meeting. The business meeting agenda is light (authorization of a labor contract with the Teamsters General Government bargaining unit that is consistent with Council's guidelines and authorization to sell a tax-acquired property at 12 Cumberland Street for \$22,000 after marketing it through our contract real estate agent RE/MAX – staff believes that given the condition of the building that is a fair market price).

Next Monday at 5:15 pm, the initial meeting of the Ad Hoc Marijuana Advisory Committee will be held in Conference Room "A". The meeting is, of course, open to the public.
