BE IT ORDERED, that Robert Corey is hereby appointed to the Planning Board said term to expire September 20, 2018.

BE IT ORDERED, that the minutes of the City Council Regular Meeting held June 21, 2018, submitted by the City Clerk's office be approved.

BE IT ORDERED, that the Roll of Accounts for the month of June, 2018 in the amount of \$7,414,325.56 be approved.

BE IT ORDERED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$7,500.00 from Dirigo Safety, LLC for the purpose of administering The Enforcement of Underage Drinking Laws (EUDL) on behalf of the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention, Tobacco and Substance Use Prevention and Control Program. The EUDL Program purpose is to reduce underage drinking and alcohol-related unintentional injuries and car crashes in Maine. There is no local match requirement in order to accept this grant funding.

Name of Street	Location	Direction of Travel
Water Street	from Winthrop Street to Bridge Street	North Only.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Augusta, as follows:

That Article II, section 270-16 Specific turns required at certain streets of the Revised Code of Ordinances 1990, as amended, be further amended by deleting the following:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Augusta, as follows:

That Article II, section 270-34 Schedule of no parking or restricted parking of the Revised Code of Ordinances 1990, as amended, be further amended by adding the following language in bold and italics:

Water Street

No parking on the east side of Water Street beginning at Bridge Street and extending southerly for a distance of 300 feet.

No parking on the west side of Water Street beginning at Bridge Street and extending southerly for a distance of 165 feet.

No winter parking from on the east side of Water St from the intersection of Winthrop St to the intersection of Bridge St. seasonally from December 15 to March 30.

With an effective date of 90 days from adoption of this ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Augusta, as follows:

That Article II, section 270-16 Specific turns required at certain streets of the Revised Code of Ordinances 1990, as amended, be further amended by deleting the following:

Name of Street	Location	Restriction
Haymarket Square Island	North Side	Straight to Front Street or left turn only
Haymarket Square Island	South Side	Right turn only
Water Street	Entering from Front Street	Right turn only

shall be hereby placed on the November 6, 2018 ballot in accordance with Article V-A, Section 7:

“Do you favor converting Water Street from Winthrop Street to Bridge Street from one-way traffic to two-way traffic as authorized by City Council Order No. 18-123?”

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that, if such question is answered in the affirmative by a majority of the voters voting thereon at such November 6, 2018 election, then this Order shall take effect upon final approval of the Maine Department of Transportation.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Augusta, as follows:

That Chapter 18, section 73 Schedule of no parking, restricted parking areas, of the Revised Code of Ordinances 1990, as amended, be further amended by removing the language with the stick through and adding the following language in bold and italics:

Middle Street

No parking ~~between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on the westerly side beginning at the intersection of Spruce Street southerly for a distance of 184 feet~~ ***to Caldwell Road***

No parking on either side from Stone Street to Spruce Street ~~and no parking on the easterly side from Spruce Street to Chestnut Street~~ ***and from Caldwell Road south to Eastern Avenue***

~~Restricted handicap parking from a point beginning 30 feet from the intersection of Middle Street and East Chestnut Street northerly on the west side of Middle Street for 20 feet.~~

~~No parking on the east or west side from the intersection of Caldwell Road southerly for a distance of 428 feet.~~
