<u>City of Augusta Property</u> - Pursuant to State Law all motorized vehicles are prohibited from all of the City of Augusta owned property without permission. This includes but is not limited to: Howard Hill (Ganneston Drive and Parkwood Road area) Bond Brook Trails (property along Bond Brook) – including the Public Works complex and all lands up to the Dragon Corporation without permission.

The insertion of any object in a tree to erect an observation stand, ladder or equipment holder is strictly prohibited on city property. MRSA 12 § 10652-B

<u>Public Works Complex (North Street)</u> - Hunters can utilize the wooded sections of the Public Works property with permission (above) but need to stay away from the "built-up" section of Public Works which would include around the buildings, the paved areas and any areas where there is equipment or materials stored outside. Access to the wooded areas would have to be from abutting properties where you have permission to enter or you can park outside the gate and walk up the hill towards the airport to get to a hunting location. Vehicles cannot park at the gate blocking vehicular traffic.
