Summer Childcare Camps

During the school year childcare is referred to as “Before and After-School Care” and in the Summer it is referred to as a “Camp”. The Child-care Program is licensed year round.

Kinder Camp

Kinder Camp is offered for children going into Kindergarten in the fall of 2018-2019

Day Camp

Is offered for children having completed grades K—5 this 2017-18 school year. Enrollment is not based on age.

Children in both camps will participate in a variety of activities, including games, arts and crafts, performing arts, movies, gardening and an out-of-town *excursion every Wednesday.

*Excursions are subject to change due to weather conditions.

**Additional fees for some excursions will be charged.
