HAS BEEN READ AND PASSED

147 WHEREAS, University of Maine has been providing forty years of education to central Maine and to the State of Maine; and

WHEREAS, UMA was established in 1965; and

WHEREAS, the enrollment has grown from three hundred and sixty-four students to over fifty-five hundred students today; and

WHEREAS, the full-time faculty has grown from four to ninety-three; and

WHEREAS, the number of degrees offered has grown from two to thirty-eight; and

WHEREAS, the opportunities for the citizens of central Maine have been greatly enhanced by its offerings; and

WHEREAS, UMA is an integral part of the City of Augusta.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the members of the Augusta City Council join in recognizing and congratulating the University of Maine at Augusta as it celebrates its forty years of providing education to its citizens.
