ORDERED, That the City Manager is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$5,000 to conduct a structural engineering analysis of the Colonial Theater.

ORDERED, That the minutes of the City Council meeting held September 2, 2010, submitted by the City Clerk, be approved.

ORDERED, That the City Manager is hereby authorized to solicit sealed bids for the sale of the Northern Avenue Fire Station in "as is" condition with the City reserving the right to reject any and all bids.
- 144 Mayor Katz and Councilor Rollins
ORDERED, That Section III.C.5 -- Health and Dental Insurance of the City of Augusta Administrative Regulations be amended by adding a new paragraph under the Medical Insurance section:
Health insurance coverage will be provided to domestic partners at the employee's cost provided the City's insurance carrier allows for such coverage and as long as the domestic partners meet the carrier's criteria.

ORDERED, That the Moratorium ordinance 047 enacted on April 1, 2010 and extended on July 1, 2010 was intended to apply only to applications and permits for bituminous mix plants and ready mix concrete plants as associated uses to a mineral extraction license and was not intended to apply to stand alone applications where the use is an allowed or conditional use. Any such applications will be processed according to ordinance. In all other respects the moratorium remains in full force and effect.
