In a circumstance where the cost of utility work for a single family residence in the City in total exceeds \$20,000, Council will, on a case by case basis, consider requests to abate up to 50% of the otherwise applicable street opening fee.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, That the City Manager is authorized to waive 50% of the street opening fee due and payable to the City of Augusta by the Augusta Water District for the sewer line work for the McGovern property at 47 Forest Avenue.
