BE IT ORDAINED, That sections 6-291 to 6-299, 6-301 to 6-304 and section 6-306 of Chapter 6, City Services, Article IV Streets and Sidewalks, Division 3 Excavations of the Revised Code of Ordinances be deleted.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That these deleted sections be replaced with a new section added to the Revised Code of Ordinances that shall read:

Sec. 6-299 Excavation and Street Opening permit required

All excavations within the public rights of way shall require an Excavation and Street Opening permit issued by the Department of Public Works prior to performing any work in the public

right of way. All fees, work and other requirements shall conform to the City of Augusta's Excavation and Street Opening Policy.

Sec. 6-300 and Sec. 305 shall remain as currently written.
