Subject: Cottage on Hayden Road, Togus Pond, Augusta

Dear Sir:

On the recommendation of Charles Morton, Local Plumbing Inspector, this office will grant the right to properly install a holding tank for sewage, requiring that the tank be pumped when necessary and that the tank effluent be taken to a public sewage treatment facility for final disposal, or, if none is available, to a place of disposal approved in writing by the officials of the town in which disposal is to take place.

This right is based on approval from the officials of the town in which disposal is to take place and from the officials in the town where the holding tank is to be located, including the health officer. It is also contingent upon the purchase of necessary permits and proper installation to comply with the requirements of the Maine Plumbing Code and the direction of the Local Plumbing Inspector in your town.
