## Meetings:

## Other Items:

Mayor Rollins has drafted a memorandum to Council (enclosed) naming appointees to the Augusta Historic District Review Board. Per the ordinance, the Mayor's appointees are subject to Council confirmation and that is slated for Thursday's meeting. The first charge of the Board will be to recommend to Council the boundaries of the proposed district/districts.

Also, please note the agenda item for this Thursday that would provide authority to sell certain surplus property currently held by either the Department of Public Works or the Police Department. In the case of the PD, these are routine found or confiscated articles that we regularly dispose of in this manner and in the DPW it is surplus vehicles and equipment that we no longer have use for.

Based on last Thursday's discussion, Matt Nazar is working on a revised version of the proposed "Complete Streets" policy. It will be available for further discussion at next week's informational meeting.
