1823, June 12, N. line of Augusta to Pet. Cor.

Beginning on the E. line of Augusta on the E. side of the Co. Road & at the S. end of the stone wall on Benj. Brown's lower farm in Vassalboro: thence 47 1/2 W. 28 R. to S&S, S. 44 W. 59 R. to S&S. S. 33 W. 32 R. to a point about 1 R. S, of Mr. Clark's house & 5 1/2 R. distant therefrom S. 37 W. 76 R. to an apple tree in Rowland Smith's garden about 6 R. N. of his house. S. 41 1/2 W. 27 R. to a point 1 R. W. of the N.W.C. of Clark Smith's new ho., S. 53 1/2 W. 30 R. to a pt. 8' W. of a small apple tree abt. 3 R. N. of the N. Cor. of Mr. Gilleys ho., S. 61 W. 47 R. to the S. W. Cor. of E. Stackpoles barn. S. 57 W. 9 R. to a point 10' W. of the N. W. Cor. of E. Stackpoles ho. S. 47 W. 14 R. to a bunch of lilacs opposite W. A. Stackpoles & about 3 1/2 R. E. of a large oak tree. S. 36 W. 54 R to a point 4 R. E. of the S.E.C. of Mr. Drummonds barn. S. 42 W. 310 R. to a pt. 6 R. W. of Moses Ingrahams barn. S. 47 W. 32 R. to a pt. 4' in front of Ansil Churchs ho. S. 51 1/2 W. 86 R. to a pt. 4' Westerly of the N. W. cor apple tree in Mr. Walls orchard and ab. 8 R. W. of said Walls ho. S. 48 W. to a stake app. 1 1/4 R. N. W. of Ansil Bakers ho. S. 33 1/2 W. 82 R. and run 4 R. E. of a shop sd. to be owned by Mr. Church. to a stone and S. near the top of the hill N of the Mill Stream. S. 30 1/2 W. 26 R. to a point opp. and 4 R. Estly. of Alan Wings ho. S. 47 1/3 W. 47 R. to a st. in S. in line of Saml Ingrahams land, S. 40 W. 91 R to a stone & S. in Mr. Savages Field, S. 17 1/2 W. to an apple tree. S. 13 W. 39 R. to a stake in a hill near the brook No. of Pettingils, S. 28 W. 29 R. to said Pettingills land road to be 4 R. wide and the above line forming the Easterly side thereof.
