ACCEPTED AND PASSED

WHEREAS, application is made to the City Council of the City of Augusta to layout, establish and accept as a new street and public way, Blaine Avenue from Western Avenue to its intersection at Winthrop Street, so-called, as indicated by the plan by Bunker and Savage, dated December 8, 1930 and filed at the office of the City Clerk.

WHEREAS, the City Council has ordered that notice be given upon such application: All persons interested are therefore notified of the intention of the City Council to layout and establish said street and are further notified to appear before the Joint Committee of the City Council on Highways and Sewers, being the Committee of the City Council having the matter in charge, at the Aldermen's Room, City Hall, in said Augusta on March 16, 1931 at 7:30 o'clock in the evening at which time and place a hearing relative to the proposed laying out and establishing of said street will be had.
