Blaisdell as laid out into lots", and on file at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds; said point being on the northerly line of Blaisdell Street; thence westerly two hundred and ninety (290) feet along the northerly line of Blaisdell Street to a point; thence southerly forty (40) feet to a point on the southerly edge of said Blaisdell Street; thence easterly ninety (90) feet along the southerly line of Blaisdell Street; thence southerly one (1) foot; thence easterly two hundred (200) feet along the southerly edge of said Blaisdell Street to a point; thence northerly forty-one (41) feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to accept as a City Street that part of Blaisdell Street which extends westerly two hundred and ninety (290) feet from the westerly line of Sewall Street. All as shown on "Plan of Blaisdell Street", made by the Engineering Department of the City of Augusta, December 3, 1947, and on file with the City Clerk.

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the westerly side of the river in Augusta, Maine. Beginning at a point at the southwesterly corner of Lot 8, as shown on plan entitled "A portion of Property owned by S. D. Blaisdell as laid out into lots", and on file at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds, said point being the northwesterly corner of Blaisdell Street and Sewall Street; thence westerly seven hundred sixty feet (760') along the northerly line of Blaisdell Street to a point on the easterly line of a proposed street; thence southerly

forty feet (40') in a line parallel to the westerly line of Sewall Street to a point on the southerly line of Blaisdell Street; thence easterly five hundred sixty feet (560') along the southerly line of Blaisdell Street; thence southerly one foot (1'); thence easterly two hundred feet (200') along the southerly line of said Blaisdell Street to the westerly line of Sewall Street; thence northerly forty-one feet (41') along the westerly line of Sewall Street to the point of beginning.
