Augusta 43 Re-location of Bog Road, so-called, leading from Augusta through Manchester and Belgrade to Mount Vernon.

Commencing at a monument in John Bean's yard in Town of Mount Vernon and running from thence South $24\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 162 rods on the east line of old road; then South $20\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 60 rods on same; then South 65 degrees West 102 rods on same; then South $42\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 34 rods on same; then South $24\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West 128 rods on same; thus far the road is to be 3 rods wide and on the southwest line of said line. Thence South $9\frac{3}{4}$ degrees East 69.5 rods on land of James Stain; thence same course 66 rods to the stream of land of John Stain; thence same 6 rods across the stream; thence North $63\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 28 rods on land of owner unknown; thence North $61\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 28 rods on same; same 29 rods on Caleb Creasy; thence South $82\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 48 rods on same; thence South 64 degrees East 56 rods on same; thence South $59\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 25 rods on Russell B. Norton; thence South 56 degrees East 35 rods on same; thence same 35 rods on Abner Cottle and Son; thence South $18\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 16 rods on same; thence South 65 degrees East 14 rods on same; thence South 89 degrees East 12 rods on same; thence South 60 degrees East 22 rods on same; thence South 42 degrees East 10 rods on same; thence South 39 degrees East 22 rods on S. S. Rollins; thence South $33\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 12 rods on same; thence South 19 degrees East 12 rods on same; thence South $7\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 10 rods on same; thence South $3\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 12 rods on estate of D. Gilman; thence South 6 degrees East 27 rods on same; thence South $37\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 23 rods on Stephen Cram; thence South $12\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 30 rods on same; thence South $2\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 9 rods on Shadrack Cram; thence South $25\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 5 rods on same; thence South 41 degrees East 9 rods on same; thence South 8 degrees East 9 rods on same; thence South 14 degrees West 27 rods on same; thence South 1 degree West 14 rods on same; thence South $17\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 29 rods on same; thence South $17\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 29 rods on same; thence South $39\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 66 rods on same; thence South 33 rods on Stephen Cram; thence South $33\frac{3}{4}$ degrees East 10 rods on same; thence same 49 rods on Smith Cram to the County Road; thence same 3 rods across said road, thence South $40\frac{3}{4}$ degrees East 7 rods on Smith Cram; thence South $28\frac{3}{4}$ degrees East 35 rods on Thomas W. Smith or unknown; thence same 7 rods on E. Clough; thence same 4 rods across and to east side of old road. This last section of new cut, the road to be four rods wide and on the southwest side of said line. Thence South $34\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 13 rods on north line of old road; thence South 47 degrees East 141 rods on same; thence South $34\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 57 rods on same; thence South $41\frac{3}{4}$ degrees East 58 rods on same; thence South 40 degrees East 22 rods on the same old road to Town line of Belgrade; thence South 40 degrees East 62 rods on same; thence South $38\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 88 rods on same; thence South $34\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 117 rods the

Androscoggin and Kennebec Railroad; thence South 34 ½ degrees East 206 rods on old road, thence South 97 degrees East 11 rods on land owner unknown to the Hall Road (so-called), this last section on old road, the location is to be 3 rods wide and on southerly side of said line; thence North 45 degrees East 9 rods on the Hall Road to a monument on the west side of the road; thence South 45 ½ degrees East 3 rods across said road; thence same 170 rods to a stone on the location of the Petition of Ruel Williams on the last course and distance the road is to be 4 rods wide and on the south side of said line. Thence we proceeded to make an alteration from the last monument to a stone monument south of Wm. Sanford's in the Town of Kennebec, to wit, as follows:

Commencing at the stone named, 170 rods from the Hall Road and running South 18 ½ degrees East 201 rods, the Belgrade line; then same course 64 rods on or near the old location; then South 38 ½ degrees East 17 ½ rods on same; then South 20 degrees East 15 rods on same; then South 32 degrees East 22 rods on same; then South 11 degrees East 16 rods on same; South 26 ½ degrees East 18 rods on same; thence South 14 ½ degrees East 34 rods on same; then South 4 ¾ degrees East 178 rods on same to the stone south of the dwelling house of Wm. Sanford in the Town of Kennebec, on this alteration the road to be 4 rods wide and on the south side of said line.

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Augusta 45 Road leading from Mount Vernon to Augusta to Coombs Mills in Augusta.

Beginning at a stone monument in the south line of the Bog Road (so-called) in Augusta at a point in said line five rods from the south west corner of Benjamin Lovejoy's house; thence North 69 degrees West 7 ½ rods on said Lovejoy's land; thence same course 18 ½ rods; thence North 36 ½ degrees West 11 rods; thence North 7 degrees East 8 rods; thence North 18 degrees West 19 rods; thence North 2 ½ degrees West 8 rods; thence North 3 ½ degrees East 26 rods; thence North 36 degrees West 6 rods on Abner Coombs' land; thence same course 8 rods; thence North 31 ½ degrees West 15 rods; thence North 30 degrees West 24 ½ rods to the brook and on Edmund Black's land; thence North 22 ½ degrees West 24 rods on land of John Jewett; thence North 49 degrees West 31 rods; thence North 60 ½ degrees West 8 rods; thence North 73 ½ degrees West 20 rods; thence South 61 degrees West 7 rods to the brook on John Allen's land; thence North 86 degrees West 18 rods; thence North 59 degrees West 21 ½ rods; thence North 41 ½ degrees West 5 ½ rods on Samuel Wood's land; thence North 56 ½ degrees West 40 rods; thence North 16 ½ degrees West 7 rods; thence North 31 degrees West 6 rods; thence North 49 ½ degrees West 10 rods; thence North 74 ½ degrees West 3 rods on land of William Vaughn; thence same course 6 rods; thence North 85 degrees West 19 rods; North 65 degrees West 24 rods; thence North 83 degrees West 6 rods; thence South 77 degrees West 17 rods; thence South 79 degrees West 14 rods; thence North 80 degrees West 6 ½ rods; thence North 69 ½ degrees West 9 ½ rods; thence North 43 ½ degrees West 25 rods to Manchester Town line and thence North 28 degrees West 23 rods; thence North 52 ½ degrees West 17 rods and on land of George Knowles; thence same

course 10 rods; thence North 45 ½ degrees West 46 ½ rods; thence North 23 degrees West 26 ½ rods; thence North 37 ½ degrees West 18 ½ rods and on land of J. Knowles; thence North 57 ½ degrees West 17 ½ rods; thence North 64 degrees West 31 rods; thence North 71 degrees West 14 rods; thence North 67 degrees West 9 rods and on land of Harrison Lyon; thence same course 26 ½ rods; thence North 65 degrees West 56 rods; thence North 81 degrees West 24 rods; thence South 85 ½ degrees West 29 rods and on land of Henry A. Caldwell; thence same course 10 rods on land of Virgil Scribner to a stone monument in the east line of the Old County Road leading from Augusta to Mount Vernon, said road to be four rods wide and to lie on the southerly side of said courses and distances and stone monuments marked R are erected at all above angles.
