179 ORDERED, That Brentwood Street, so-called, as described below, be accepted as a City Street, upon compliance with the State of Maine Statutes, as amended, the City of Augusta Ordinances and upon proper execution of agreement drafted and approved by the Corporation Counsel. Said street to be 50 feet wide.

Beginning at a point on the northerly line of the Old Winthrop Road and said point being the southeasterly corner of Lot #2 according to plan of Westwood Park - Section #1 made April 18 1955; thence northerly along the easterly line of Lots #2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22, 24 to the northeasterly corner of Lot #24 a distance of nine hundred and sixty and twenty-five hundredths (960.25') feet; thence easterly fifty feet (50') to the northwesterly corner of Lot #23; thence southerly along the westerly line of Lots #23, 21, 19, 17, 15, 13, 11, 9, 7, 5, 3, and 1 to the northerly line of Old Winthrop Road and distance of nine hundred and sixty (960') feet; thence westerly along said Old Winthrop Road fifty feet (50') to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land to be used as a City Street nine hundred sixty (960') feet long northerly of the Old Winthrop Road and fifty feet (50') wide.

170 ORDERED, That the extension of Brentwood Road, description below, be accepted.

Beginning at a point on the westerly side of Brentwood Road, so-called, as accepted August 17, 1959, at the northeasterly corner of Lot No. 24 as shown on Plan of Westwood Park,

Section No. 1, dated April 18, 1955; thence northerly in the continuation of the westerly side of said Brentwood Road 140 feet; thence easterly at right angles 50 feet to the easterly side of said Brentwood Road; thence southerly along the easterly side of said Brentwood Road 140 feet to the northwesterly corner of Lot No. 23, as shown on above-mentioned Plan; thence westerly at right angles 50 feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land 50 feet wide extending 140 feet northerly from the end of the present Brentwood Road as accepted August 17, 1959 and recorded in the Journal of the Board of Alderman Volume 22, on Page 218, on file in the City Clerk's Office at Augusta City Hall.

Know All Men by These Presents,

That We, George E. Peachey and Victor K. Peachey, both of Augusta, Lafayette E. Peachey and Sidney R. Peachey, both of Mount Vernon, all in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine, co-partners, doing business under the name and style of Peachey Builders,

in consideration of one dollar and other valuable considerations paid by the City of Augusta, a municipal corporation, duly established by law and located at Augusta in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said City of Augusta, its successors

and assigns forever, a certain lot or parcel of land situated in said Augusta and bounded and described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the north line of the Old Winthrop Road, three hundred and ten feet (310.00) east of the intersection of the easterly line of Westwood Road with the northerly line of the Old Winthrop Road; said point being as shown on Plan of Westwood Corporation, Section I, by W. W. Hill C. E., dated January 9, 1952, and recorded in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds, Plan Book 17, Page 100; thence running in an easterly direction at an included angle of 90 degrees 17 minutes, a distance of nine hundred and sixty (960) feet; said line being parallel with said Westwood Road, and being the westerly street line of Brentwood Road. The easterly street line of said Brentwood Road being 50.00 (fifty) feet easterly therefrom and parallel to previously described westerly line of said Brentwood Road.
