READ AND PASSED

At a special meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Augusta qualified to vote on Town affairs duly and legally notified and held at the Town House in said Augusta on Monday the 23rd day of March A.D. 1846 at two o'clock in the afternoon.

ARTICLE 2 VOTED, To accept a road laid out by the Selectmen upon the petition of J. M. C. Burbank and others according to the report of the laying out of the same which petition and report are as follows viz:

To the Selectmen of Augusta

The undersigned respectfully request that a way be laid out twenty feet in width from the Eastern Avenue to Cedar Street, the west line of the way to be located on lot east of the east line of lots owned by Isaac H. Randall, Gilbert Pullen and S. Lancaster and the east line to be twenty feet easterly there upon.

March 11, 1846

The undersigned Selectmen of Augusta have this day laid out upon the within petition the following road. Beginning on the north line of Eastern Avenue at a post in the corner of the fence; thence running North 19 1/2 degrees East 15 3/4 rods to Cedar Street, this being the east line of the location and to be one rod and six links wide.

All parties were notified by posting up two notices more than seven days prior to this date.
