READ AND PASSED

ORDER A-364 A certain lot or parcel of land on the west side of the river in Augusta, Maine and described as follows; to wit;

Beginning at a point on the north side of Child Street and being the southwest corner of Lot #9 according to "Plan of Lots Surveyed for W.D. Hutchins"; thence northerly on the westerly line of Lots #9, 8 and 7 a distance of one hundred ninety-nine and twenty-four hundredths (199.24') feet to the north line of Lot #7; thence westerly thirty feet (30'); thence southerly along the easterly, line of a part of Lot #3, Lot #2 and a continuation of said line a distance of one hundred ninety-nine and twenty-four hundredths feet (199.24') to the north line of Child Street; thence easterly on the north line of Child Street thirty and seven hundredths (30.07') feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land two hundred feet more or less (200'±) long and thirty (30') feet wide extending northerly from Child Street.
