255 ORDERED, That Cherry Street, description below, be vacated.

Description

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the west side of the river in Augusta, Maine: Beginning at a point on the northerly side of Gray Street, so-called, located 190 feet westerly of the westerly side of State Street, so-called, thence North 62 degrees 48 minutes West along the northerly side of said Gray Street 40 feet to the southeasterly corner of Lot No. 153 as shown on Plan of Belmont Park on file at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds; thence North 27 degrees 12 minutes East in a line parallel with and 230 feet westerly of the westerly line of said State Street 248 feet to the southerly line of King Street, so-called, thence South 62 degrees 48 minutes East along the southerly side of said King Street 40 feet to the northwesterly corner of Lot No. 149 as shown on above mentioned plan; thence South 27 degrees 12 minutes West in a line parallel with and 190 feet westerly of the westerly line of said State Street 248 feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land 40 feet wide and 248 feet long shown as Cherry Street on above mentioned plan.
