That the City Clerk gave the notice required by the charter of the City warning all persons interested to appear before this Committee at his office on Saturday the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September 1887 at 2 o'clock p.m. to show cause why said street should not be laid out and to make claim for damages. And after due hearing thereon your Committee laid out said street as follows.

Beginning at State Street at the place where said Child Street now is and running easterly to Gage Street on land of Henry G. Staples, Daniel J. Pike and Mrs. Doyle.
