READ AND ACCEPTED

To the Honorable Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Augusta:

The undersigned citizens of the City of Augusta hereby request your Honorable Board to layout a street in said City, leading easterly from lower State Street, between the residences of Leander Taylor and Perley M. Lawrence to land of Patrick Coughlin, the land, on either side of said street being now occupied by residences. We respectfully request, therefore, that such action be taken by your Board as may be necessary for the purpose of the laying out such street.

Upon the foregoing Petition it is ORDERED that written notices thereof be posted according to law and that a hearing thereon be given by the Joint Standing Committee on Highways and Sewers at the Aldermen's Room, May 15, 1911 at 7:30 p.m., at which time and place all persons interested and appearing may be heard.

The foregoing Petition and Order of Notice thereon were Read, the Petition accepted and Order of Notice Passed, both being Sent Down for Concurrence. Returned by the Common Council endorsed for Concurrent Action.

Pursuant to the action of the City Council the following notice was given:

WHEREAS, Application is made to the City Council of the City of Augusta to layout a new street, beginning at a point in the easterly line of lower State Street, so-called, between the residences of Leander Taylor and P. M. Lawrence; thence easterly to land of Patrick Coughlin:

And WHEREAS, said City Council has directed an order of Notice upon said application:

All persons interested are therefore notified of the intention of the City Council to layout said street and are hereby further notified to appear before the Joint Committee of the City Council on Highways and Sewers at the Aldermen's Room, City Building, in said Augusta, on May 15th, A.D., 1911, at 7:30 in the afternoon, at which time and place a hearing relative to the proposed laying out of said street will be had.

The following report of the Committee on Highways and Sewers was accepted, and the accompanying Order was Read and Passed, both being sent down for Concurrence and returned by the Common Council endorsed for Concurrent Action.

The Joint Standing Committee on Highways and Sewers to whom was referred the matter of laying out a new street easterly from Lower State Street between land of P. M. Lawrence and L. F. Taylor, having considered the matter therein, beg leave to report that the acceptance of

said street, as laid out by plan and surveyor's description attached, becomes a public necessity. The Committee recommends the passage of the accompanying Order.

Bounds and Admeasurements of Taylor Street.

Surveyor's Description

Beginning at a point in the east side of State Street eight hundred and forty-five feet (845) north of the stone monument on the Hallowell line and measured along the east side of State Street; thence South 61 degrees and 30 minutes East a distance of three hundred and ninety-five feet (395) to an intersection with another proposed street. All of above being in accordance with a plan of the original division of property of Mr. Patrick Coughlin made by R. B. Capen in 1892. Reference is hereby made to a copy of such plan filed with this description.
