

## Steps for arranging overnight parking in downtown Augusta:

- 1- Purchase a RESIDENT parking permit from the Augusta Parking District, which will include a free “Overnight Parking” permit from the Augusta Police Department.
- 2- Register with the **Emergency Notification System** to receive alert messages regarding snow events and other parking conditions/situations.

### WINTER REGULATIONS

(in effect from November 15 through April 15, yearly)

“Downtown winter snow operations” involve the following:

- 1) **Snow Plowing** during a storm, and
- 2) **Snow Removal** after a storm when snowbanks are removed and hauled away.

Winter overnight parking (4:00 PM until 8:00 AM daily) is permitted in the areas shown on the map in this brochure.

During snow plowing events residents must have their vehicles in one of these locations by Midnight. These areas are signed, “Free Overnight Parking Daily, 4 PM to 8 AM unless posted otherwise.”

If you park in the Dickman Street Parking Garage, you must move your vehicle from the garage by 8:00 AM (M-F) when parking enforcement starts.

### SNOW REMOVAL AND MAINTENANCE

In the event the city needs to remove snow, the city will place temporary “No Overnight Parking Tonight” signs in that area(s) on the day that the snow needs to be removed. Residents should park in the Parking Garage when they see one of these signs in the area they want to park.

The City will use the **Emergency Notification System** to alert downtown residents of snow removal activities. It is **strongly recommended** that all downtown residents register with the **Emergency Notification System** at [www.augustamaine.gov](http://www.augustamaine.gov) in order to avoid citations, fines, and possible towing expenses.

**CITYWIDE PARKING BAN:** If a citywide parking ban is announced, please park in the parking garage regardless of the time of day. A city-wide parking ban will be announced via broadcast media, Facebook, and through the emergency notification system only, **no temporary signs will be placed.**
