READ AND PASSED

201 ORDERED, That Drake Avenue, description below, be discontinued.

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the east side of the Kennebec River in Augusta, Maine more completely described as follows: Beginning at a point on the southerly side of North Belfast Avenue (U.S. Route 202) said point being the northeasterly corner of Lot #25 as shown on Plan of Eastwood by E. F. Pooler dated April 1955 on file in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds in Plan Book 17B, Page 170 to which reference is hereby made for clarity; thence, running southerly 239.3 feet to an angle point; thence, running on an interior angle of 162 degrees 15 minutes, 43.7 feet to an angle point; thence, running on an interior angle of 134 degrees 25 minutes, 415.7 feet to the westerly side of Boucher Avenue; thence, running on an interior angle of 87 degrees 53 minutes, about 40 feet to the southeasterly corner of Lot #6 on said plan; thence, running on an interior angle of 92 degrees 07 minutes, 397.8 feet to an angle point; thence, running on an interior angle of 218 degrees 03 minutes, 35 feet to an angle point; thence, running on an interior angle of 196 degrees 14 minutes, 215.3 feet to the southerly side of North Belfast Avenue; thence, running an interior angle of 111 degrees 50 minutes, 43.7 feet to a point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe that parcel denoted as Drake Avenue as shown on aforementioned plan.

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
