

A-159 ORDERED, That Ovila Godin, James Duncan, and Paul Lalibertie, employees of the Highway Department and all over the age of seventy years, be continued on in their present capacity beyond the compulsory retirement date so long as they are willing and perform their work as satisfactory as at present. Read and passed by both branches.

A-160 ORDERED, That the Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to accept from Carroll Burns the sum of \$356.95 in full settlement of taxes, interest and costs for the year 1909, 1916 and 1934-1941 on land and buildings at 5 Clark St., providing said sum is paid within thirty days of the date hereof.

And be it further ordered that said Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to execute a quitclaim deed from the City of Augusta to said Burns upon the payment of the same, covering the interest of said City to said premises by virtue of tax deeds and tax liens for said years.
