C-73 ORDERED, That Fairbanks Street, so-called, as described below, be accepted as a City Street, upon compliance with the State of Maine Statutes, as amended, the City of Augusta Ordinances and upon proper execution of agreement drafted and approved by the Corporation Counsel. Said street to be 40 feet wide.

DESCRIPTION

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the westerly side of Sewall Street so-called, on the west side of the river in Augusta, Maine.

Beginning at a point on the west side of said Sewall Street located 442.42 feet southerly of the southeast corner of Blaisdell Street and Sewall Street said point being the northeast corner of Lot #71 according to "Plan of Addition to Forest Park" made December 12, 1958 by J. Weisendanger Engineer; thence westerly along the northerly line of Lot #71, 72,73,74 and 75 a distance of 400 feet to the northwest corner of Lot # 75; thence at right angle northerly 40 feet to the northwest corner of Lot #76; thence easterly on the southerly line of Lot #76, 77, 78, 79 and 80, 400 feet to the west line of Sewall Street; thence southerly along the westerly side of said Sewall Street 40 feet to the point of beginning; meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land 400 feet long and 40 feet wide to be known as Fairbanks Street.
