A-345 ORDERED, That Fairfield Street, extending from Pearl Street easterly 366 feet be accepted as a City Street. Said street to be 40 feet wide.

Beginning at a point on the southeasterly line of Pearl Street and said point being two hundred feet (200') southerly of the southerly line of Fowler Street; thence southeasterly on a line parallel to said Fowler Street a distance of three hundred sixty-six feet (366') thence at 90 degrees southerly forty feet (40'); thence at 90 degrees westerly a distance of three hundred sixty-six feet (366') to the southeasterly line of Pearl Street; thence northerly on said Pearl Street forty feet (40') to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land to be used as a City Street 366 feet long and 40 feet wide.
