WHEREAS, application is made to the City Council of the City of Augusta to layout, establish and accept as new streets and public ways, Pearl Street Extension from Quimby Street to Fowler Street so-called, and Fowler Street from Bangor Street to the eastern end of the lot of Charles Nichols abutting on Fowler Street as indicated by the plan presented with the order.

WHEREAS, the City Council has ordered that notice be given upon such application;

All persons interested are therefore notified of the intention of the City Council to layout and establish said streets and are further notified to appear before the joint committee of the City Council on Highways and Sewers being the Committee of the City Council having the matter in charge, at the Aldermen's Room, City Building, in said Augusta on October 8, 1923 at 2 o'clock in the afternoon at which time and place a hearing relative to the proposed laying out of and establishing said streets will be had.
