DESCRIPTION OF FULLER ROAD

August 8, 1955

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the west side of the River in Augusta, Maine and described as follows: Beginning at a point on the southerly line of the Old Winthrop Road and said point being the northwest corner of lot #1 according to "Plan of lots on Property of Joseph E. Delahunty" made by Henry F. Hill, Jr., May 10, 1955; thence southwesterly along the westerly line of lots #1,2,3 and part of 4 a distance of two hundred seventy three and eighty line hundredths feet (273.89') to an angle point; thence more southerly at an angle of 178 51' along the westerly line of lots #4,5,6 and 7 a distance of two hundred eighty nine and twenty one hundredths feet (289.21') to the southwest corner of lot #7; thence N 56 20'W at an angle of 86 56' a distance of fifteen and five hundredths feet (15.05') along the northerly line of Raymond J.L. Simmons; thence in a continuation of the same line a distance of twenty five feet (25') to an iron pipe at an angle point on the easterly line of Harold L. Drew; thence northeasterly along said Drew's line a distance of two hundred eighty seven and thirty five hundredths feet (287.35') to the southeast corner of land of Roy A Wentzel; thence more easterly at an angle of 178 51' along the easterly line of said Wentzel to the southerly line of Old Winthrop Road; thence easterly along said Old Winthrop Road south line a distance of forty two and twenty six hundredths feet (42.26') to the point of beginning. Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land to be used as a city street five hundred sixty-three feet (563') along and forty feet (40') wide extending southerly from the Old Winthrop Road.
