

EXHIBIT A (GAGE STREET DISCONTINUANCE)

(Northerly portion from Memorial Bridge Drive)

Discontinuing that portion of Gage Street, northerly from Memorial Bridge Drive and extending to Water Street and shown on plan entitled "Maine State Highway Commission Right of Way Map, State Highway Q, Augusta, Kennebec County, Federal Aid Project No. F.I.U.I. 389(2), S.H.C. File No. 6-43, dated March 1948."

Gage Street was accepted by the Selectmen of Augusta on March 7, 1842 as 40 feet wide in Volume 2 from the Book of Records-Pages 269 & 275. A portion of Gage Street, near Water Street was altered on March 24, 1845 in Volume 3 from the Journal of the Board of Aldermen-Page 63. A portion of Gage Street, near Water Street, was widened on March 24, 1845, in Street Book 1833-Pages 44 & 45.

Reserving a utility easement for any utilities in existence on the date of the vote of this order. Also reserving a public easement on the easterly side of the street twenty feet (20 ') in width from Memorial Drive to Water Street.
