A-367 ORDERED, A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the westerly side of the river in Augusta, Maine. Beginning at a point in the southerly line of Taylor Street, so-called, said point being in the northwesterly corner of Lot 75, and two hundred feet (200') easterly of the easterly line of State Street; thence South 27 degrees 12 minutes West along the westerly line of Lots 75, 76, 77, 78 and part of 79 a distance of two hundred sixty-five and one hundredth feet (265.01'); thence at a right angle North 62 degrees 48 minutes West forty feet (40') to the southeasterly corner of Lot 71; thence at a right angle North 27 degrees 12 minutes East along the easterly line of Lots 71, 72, 73, and 74 to the northeasterly corner of Lot 74 a distance of two hundred sixty-five and one hundredth feet (265.01'); thence at a right angle South 62

degrees 48 minutes East forty feet (40') to the point of beginning, meaning and intending to convey that part of George Street, so-called, as designated on plan entitled "Plan of Survey for the Titcomb Real Estate Association" by E. E. Greenwood and Company Engineers, on file at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds in Plan Book 7, Page 83, extending from the south side of Taylor Street to the south line of Lot 71.
