6 ORDERED, That Green Acre Road, description below, be accepted as a City Street.

A certain lot or parcel of land located on the west side of the river in Augusta, Maine. Beginning at a point on the westerly side of the Middle Road, so-called, at the northeasterly corner of Lot #1 as shown on a plan of "Leon B. Dumont Development" by Walter B. Lovett; said plan being filed at the Kennebec Registry of Deeds in plan Book 44, Page 43. Thence running northwesterly 450 feet along the northeasterly line of Lots 1, 2, 3 to a point; thence turning an angle of 90 degrees to the right and running northeasterly 50 feet to a point; thence turning an angle of 90 degrees to the right and running southeasterly 450 feet to a point on the westerly side of the Middle Road; thence turning an angle of 90 degrees to the right and running 50 feet along the westerly side of the Middle Road to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land 50 feet wide and 450 feet long to be used as a City Street known as Green Acre Road.
