HALIFAX STREET (PETITION)

PETITION for Order to Vacate Street Location on Plans Street

To the Municipal Officers of the City of Augusta, Maine:

Joseph A. Veilleux and Gladys Veilleux both of Augusta, Maine, respectfully represent to your Honorable Board, that they are the owners of the fee in certain land lying in said Augusta, more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land 40 (forty) feet wide and shown and designated as Halifax Street on a certain plan entitled "Plan of Hilltop Development, Joseph A. Veilleux et al property" dated July, 1961 and filed in Kennebec Registry of Deeds in Plan Book 24, Page 49. Said area so designated as Halifax Street being forty (40) feet wide and approximately six hundred three and three-tenths (603.3) feet in length.

Your petitioners further represent that certain lots shown on said plan have been sold by reference to said plan.

Your petitioners further represent that no part of said area designated as Halifax Street has ever been accepted by the City of Augusta, or located as a public way.

Wherefore they pray that your Honorable Board may order that the proposed location of a street over said strip of land, be vacated.

This petition is brought under the Provisions of Section 3012 of Title 23 of the Maine Revised Statutes Annotated. Dated at Augusta, Maine, this 2nd day of September, 1966.
