Dear Corey:

On November 3, 2014, in accordance with Section 6-35(f)(3)(d) of the Augusta Code of Ordinances, the Augusta Historic Preservation Commission held a public hearing regarding 32 Court Street. The Commission recommends that the Planning Board find that the building is significant based on the following criteria:

1. The building has documented associations, to the satisfaction of the Historic Preservation Commission, with one or more historic persons or events, or with the broad architectural, cultural, economic or social history of the City, the state or the nation (Code of Ordinances, Section 6-35(g)(4)).
2. The building has documented historical or architectural importance in terms of period, style, method of construction, specific use, or association with a recognized builder or architect, either by itself or in the context of a group of buildings (Code of Ordinances, Section 6-35(g)(5)).
