

HOSPITAL STREET

1806. Beginning at the burying ground on the East side of the river thence running North 21 ½ degrees East 78 Rods to top of the hill thence North 16 degrees East 188 Rods to a cedar post in the fence near Rev. Mr. Stone’s barn. Thence North 30 degrees West 18 Rods to East line of Cony Road thence on the line of said road to Bridge 10 Rods said road to be 4 Rods wide and West of above line.

1834 From a short distance Easterly of Caleb Wilson’s dwelling ho. to Cony’s Corner.

Beginning at a stone bound marked ‘R’ a short distance Easterly of Caleb Wilson’s dwelling house, from thence running North 55 degrees West 24 Rods North 72 degrees West 130 Rods North 57 degrees West 56 Rods North 64 ½ degrees West 63 Rods North 50 degrees West 22 Rods to South corner of Chadwicks barn 43 ½ degrees West 172 Rods North 52 ½ degrees West 233 Rods North 66 degrees West 154 Rods to West line of Cony Road to a stone monument marked R.X. the foregoing line is the North line of the road.

Commencing at a stone moument (Corner of Thomaston Road) thence running North 18 degrees East along said old Cony Road 52 Rods to a stone marked “R” thence North 15 degrees West 46 Rods to a stone thence North 20 degrees West 10 Rods to a stone marked “R” thence North 23 ½ degrees West 48 Rods to a stone monument marked “R” to the Northeast corner of Ruel Williams garden. Road to be 4 Rods wide and above is the West line.

ORDERED, That the name of Hospital Street, so-called, be and hereby is discontinued from East Chestnut Street to Eastern Avenue, thereby leaving its northern terminus at Eastern Avenue, and that the title of Stone Street, so-called, be and hereby is continued from East Chestnut to Eastern Avenue so that its southern terminus shall be at Eastern Avenue.
