The Committee on New Streets to whom was referred the petition of Collins Howe and others respectfully ask leave to report that, due notice having been given that after having viewed the premises and heard the parties we proceeded to locate the following road, to wit:

Beginning in the south west corner of a lot of land of R. A. Cony between the fourth and fifth ranges; thence running North 29 ½ degrees West on the line of said ranges about 130 rods to the south east corner of G. Barrows' Clark lot; thence northerly about 80 rods to the New Belfast Road at a point 15 rods westerly from the easterly line of said Clark lot the above line will be the center of the road and road to be four rods wide. No damages claimed.

The Committee report the above location on the following conditions, to wit: That but thirty dollars shall be expended the present year by the City and that no other appropriation shall be made for the construction of said road until 1854 and that the settlers for whose benefit and convenience the above road is laid, shall, at their own expense, grant and make probable this season, the portion of the road as first reported to wit: 130 rods.
