M-127 ORDERED, That the petition of Henry J. Lahaye and Albetine M. Lahaye, dated November 19, 1956 to vacate a portion of Kennebec Street in accordance with Chapter 96, Sec. 46 of the Revised Statutes of Maine, be considered.

The portion of Kennebec Street in said Augusta be vacated being a strip of land 40 feet in width and extending northerly 100 feet more or less from the northerly line of Riverton Street reserving, however, the right to the City of Augusta for a turn around adjacent to the northerly line of Riverton Street for highway equipment and also reserving the right to Delmont Cooper, his heirs, and assigns, to use a strip of land 15 feet wide along the westerly boundary of said parcel for a right of way to and from his property which lies westerly of the above mentioned property.

Notice of this land and petition was posted November 20, 1956 for hearing December 17, 1956.

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
