To the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Augusta

Gentlemen:

The undersigned respectfully represents that she has heretofore only had access to her land by sufferance of Benjamin Getchell over whose land she is obliged to pass, and as obstacles have been place in the way over which she has formerly occupied and is thereby deprived of any possible way out or in, she therefore prays that the City authorities will forthwith layout and open a public street beginning in the southerly terminus of the street leading by the house of the said Benjamin Getchell; southerly to the northerly line of land of the heirs of John Getchell.

The Committee on New Streets to whom was referred the petition of Mahala Getchell praying that a public street may be laid out for her accommodation having attended to that duly, report that having given legal notice, they proceeded to layout a street beginning in the southerly terminus of the street leading by the house of Benjamin Getchell; thence running South 40 degrees West distance eight rods and ten feet to the north line of land of the heirs of John Getchell. Width of road to correspond with the road leading by the house of said Benjamin Getchell the same being one rod in width. The Committee accessed damages to Benjamin Getchell in the sum of eight dollars.

The undersigned hereby represent that she is subjected to much trouble and inconvenience for want of an established, public or private way to her land, the distance from the south end of the present public way on the land of Benjamin Getchell to her land being but about 6 or 8 rods. She therefore requests that a public way may be laid out and established from said south end thereof to her land and if not deemed for the public benefit that the same may be laid out and established as a private way.

The Committee on New Streets to whom was referred the petition of Mahala Getchell for a public or private way.

June 29, 1861

Report that they have examined the premises and find that distance from the south end of the road as established by the County Commissioners in 1848 to the land of said petitioner is nearly nine rods. That the width of the southerly part of said road is but one rod and that the damages and cost of making the road to her land if same width would be but a small sum which would soon be repaid by the taxes on the land of the petitioner, which has not been taxed for the reason in part that she had no road to the same. We therefore recommend that the present road be continued to the land of the petitioner as a public way.

Report of Committee on New Streets of the laying out of a new street on petition of Mahala Getchell.

The undersigned have this day laid out as a public way a new street as asked for by the petitions of Mahala Getchell upon which notice was ordered by the City Council at their last meeting. Notice having been given as required by Chapter 15 of the City Ordinances and as appears by the notice of the City Clerk and return of the City Marshal thereon herewith returned said street as laid out by us is described as follows, to wit:

Commencing at a stone in the wall marked R in the east line of the road laid out as a Town way by the County Commissioners in 1848 and at the south end of said east line being on the land of Benjamin Getchell near the east bank of Kennebec River and from thence; running South 63 1/2 degrees West eight rods and ten links to a stone bound set by us on the south side of the fence between the lands of Benjamin Getchell and Mahala Getchell said road is laid out one rod in width and on the westerly side of said line, and we have appropriated the damages to the estate of

Benjamin Getchell in consequence of the establishment of said way or street at the sum of twenty dollars to be paid by the City after said road is built.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Augusta have been petitioned by Mahala Getchell to layout a street or road in said City: Commencing at the south end of the present public way on land of Benjamin Getchell and running about six or eight rods from said south end through the land of said Mahala Getchell to and terminates at the line of said Mahala Getchell's land and the said Council at a session thereof on the twenty-seventh day of July 1861 ordered the City Clerk to give notice of the intention of said Council to layout said proposed street or road. All persons interested are hereby notified to appear before a Committee of said Council at the premises at 10 o'clock a.m. on the 22nd day of August 1861 when and where said Committee will proceed to layout the same.
