Know All Men by These Presents,

That N.P. DODGE CORPORATION, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware and located at Omaha, in the County of Douglas and State of Nebraska, in consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration

paid by the City of Augusta, a municipal corporation duly organized and existing by law and located in Augusta in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine,

the receipt whereof do hereby acknowledge, do hereby remise, release, bargain, sell and convey and forever quit-claim unto the said City of Augusta, its successors

and assigns forever, a certain parcel or lot of land situated on the west side of the river in Augusta, Maine, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the easterly line of Sewall Street and said point being the southwest corner of Lot #25 according to Plan of "Belmont Park"; thence easterly along the southerly

line of Lots #25, 29, 38, 41, and 52 to the west line of South Grove Street, a distance of three hundred eighty-six and fifty-two hundredths feet (386.52'); thence southerly on said South Grove Street line forty feet (40') to the northeast corner of Lot #51; thence westerly along the northerly line of Lots #51, 42, 37, 30, and 24 to the easterly line of Sewall Street, a distance of three hundred eighty-four and nine hundredths feet (384.09'); thence northerly on said line of Sewall Street forty and seven hundredths feet (40.07') to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land forty feet (40') wide between Sewall Street and South Grove Street.
