Know All Men by These Presents,

That N.P. Dodge Corporation, a Corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware and located at Omaha, in the County of Douglas and State of Nebraska

in consideration of one Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration

paid by the City of Augusta, a municipal corporation duly organized and existing by law and located in Augusta in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine

the receipt whereof do hereby acknowledge, do hereby remise, release, bargain, sell and convey and forever quit-claim unto the said City of Augusta, its successors

and assigns forever, a certain lot or parcel of land situated on the west side of the river in Augusta, Maine, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Sewall Street and said point being the northwest corner of Lot #204 according to "Map of Belmont Park"; thence easterly along the southerly line of King Street a distance of nine hundred seventeen and eighty-eight hundredths (917.88') feet to the west line of State Street; thence northerly on State Street fifty feet (50'); thence westerly on the northerly line of King Street a distance of nine hundred twenty and ninety-one hundredths feet (920.91') to the east line of Sewall Street; thence southerly on Sewall Street a distance of fifty and nine hundredths feet (50.09') to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land fifty feet (50') wide and nine hundred twenty feet (920') long between State Street and Sewall Street.
