REFERRED TO HIGHWAY COMMITTEE

A-89 ORDERED, That commencing at the northwest corner of Lot 9 according to "Plan of House Lots on Patterson Street, belonging to the James Howard Estate, by R. B. Capen, 1892" and on file at the Kennebec Registry of Deeds; thence southerly along the westerly side of Lots 9, 7 and 6 and across a narrow strip of land three and a half (3 1/2) feet wide, more or less, to land of Harrison Kittredge; thence westerly along said Kittredge's north line to a point in line with the easterly line of Lot 10 extended southerly three and a half (3 1/2) feet more or less; thence northerly across said narrow strip of land and along the easterly line of Lots 10, 11, and 12, a distance of two hundred and thirty-six and a half (236.5) feet, more or less to the south line of Patterson Street; thence easterly along the south line of Patterson Street to the point of beginning.

Said strip of land being laid out on above mentioned plan of house lots as a future street, and said street shall now be accepted as a City street, to be known as Kittredge Street, and shall be forty (40) feet wide as shown on above mentioned plan, and on "Plan of Kittredge Street." Made by the City Highway Department and dated May 3, 1949, and on file with the City Clerk.

Gannett, described below:

in consideration of one dollar and other valuable consideration

paid by the City of Augusta, a body corporate and politic situated in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said City of Augusta, its successors

and assigns forever, a strip of land situated forty feet wide and extending southerly from Patterson Street to land of Harrison F.
