POSSIBLE DEED DESCRIPTION

WESTFIELD STREET

September 29, 1955

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the west side of the river in Augusta, Maine and described as follows; Beginning at a point in the northerly line of Macomber Avenue and said point being the southwest corner of Lot #6 according to Plan of Westfield Development-Outer Western Avenue made October 1940; thence northerly along the westerly line of Lots 6 and 5 a distance of 206 feet to the south line of E. M. Socec; thence westerly along said Socec line forty feet (40 feet); thence southerly along an extension of the east line of Lot #3 and the east line of Lot 3 and 4 to a point on the east line of Lot #4 and the north line of Macomber Avenue; thence easterly on Macomber Avenue 40 feet to the point of beginning.
