The following order was sent up from the Common Council, viz:

Ordered, That the Street Commissioner be and hereby is directed to open and make the new street on the east side of the river commencing at Bangor Street running west to a line of the houses of E.K. Robinson, T. Clark and J. Norcross and thence Northerly by said houses-also that said Street, so far as it runs parallel with Myrtle Street be designated by the name of "Maiden Lane" -and the same was passed in concurrence.
