READ AND PASSED

WHEREAS, application is made to the City Council of the City of Augusta to layout, establish and accept as a new street and public way, Manley Street, so-called, in accordance to a description of the proposed street to be called Manley Street.

Beginning at a stone bound on the west side of State Street distant northerly 304.68 feet from another stone bound at the northwest corner of State and Glenwood Streets. Then making an interior angle of 90 degrees 55 minutes with the west line of State Street and running westerly a distance of 448.44 feet to a stone bound on the west line of Grove Street Extension; thence onwards in the same direction a further distance of 380.46 feet to a stone bound on the east line of the Brower Lot, now owned by V. E. Dunn; thence turning an interior angle of 81 degrees 53 minutes and running southerly along the east line of the Brower Lot a distance of 40.37 feet; thence running westerly, parallel with and forty feet distance from the first above described line, a distance of 825.58 feet to an iron pipe on the west line of State Street; thence running northerly, along the west line of State Street a distance of forty feet to the place of beginning. Being a street forty feet wide, from State Street to land of Vinton E. Dunn.

WHEREAS, the City Council has ordered that notice be given upon such application: All persons interested are therefore notified of the intention of the City Council to layout and establish said street and are further notified to appear before the Joint Committee of the City Council on Highways and Sewers, being the Committee of the City Council having the matter in charge, at the Aldermen's Room, City Hall, in said Augusta on September 13, 1929 at 3:15 Standard Time in the afternoon at which time and place a hearing relative to the proposed laying out and establishing of said street will be had.
