READ AND PASSED

544 ORDERED, That Mayfair Circle, description below, be accepted as a City Street.

Beginning at the northeasterly corner of Lot No. 116, as shown on Plot Plan of Additional Residence Lots, Mayfair Subdivision, made by John L. Collins, July 1, 1968, on file in Plan Book 35 on Page 31 at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds; thence westerly in the northerly line of Lot No. 116 and the northerly line of Lot No. 115, as shown on above-mentioned Plan, about 175 feet to the northwesterly corner of said Lot No. 115; thence westerly, northerly and easterly in a circle with a radius of 42 feet along the westerly line of Lot No. 115, the easterly line of Lot No. 114, and the southerly line of Lot No. 113 to the southwestly corner of Lot No. 112, as shown on above-mentioned Plan; thence continuing easterly along the southerly side of said Lot No. 112 about 160 feet to the southeasterly corner of said Lot No. 112; thence southerly about 40 feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to accept all of Mayfair Circle, so-called, as shown on above-mentioned Plan.
