READ AND PASSED~

ORDER 346, BE IT ORDAINED, By the City Council of the City of Augusta, as follows:~

That Chapter 20, Section 20-13 of the Revised Code of Ordinances 1970, as amended, be further amended as follows:~

That subsection (g) be added which reads as follows:~

The west side rotary known as Memorial Circle shall be numbered beginning at the point where "Memorial Drive" begins (running easterly from P. C. Station 90+47.04 as shown on a map of State Highway Q dated March 1948 and revised May 1949, Sheet 1 of 5, S.H.C. File No. 6-43, recorded in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds, Plan Book 17 pp 58-59) with number 1 Memorial Circle being allotted to the first property located north of "Memorial Drive" and abutting the most northeast segment of the rotary right-of-way, which property is presently owned by Dulac, with the numbers increasing in a counter-clockwise direction around said rotary. There shall be a number allotted for every lot of land fronting on the rotary (as defined by its' extreme right-of-way limits and lack of a street address) for each fifty feet of frontage on same. The provisions of sub-chapter (f) of this section shall apply to Memorial Circle.~

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
