The following application was read and accepted in both branches:

APPLICATION, That the city accept Mt. Vernon Court as a City Street.

The following order was read and referred to the Committee on Highways and Sewers:

ORDERED, That the application of Joseph Laliberty and seven others presented at the meeting to the City Council to lay out and establish a new street, known as Mt Vernon Court, be and hereby is accepted, and that the City Council hereby directs an order of notice upon such application in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 12 of the Revised Ordinances, of the intention of the City Council to lay out the same and of a hearing thereon, before the Joint Standing Committee on Highways and Sewers to be held at 7:30 o'clock in the afternoon on the 21st day of November 1927, at the City Council rooms in said city; and that the foregoing matter be referred to the said Committee on Highways and Sewers.
