

**MUD MILL ROAD**

**AUGUSTA**

Road from the east line of Windsor through Augusta to the end of the road leading to Pittston in Chelsea.

Beginning at a stone marked "R" in the east line in the County of Kennebec on the dividing line between the Town of Windsor and Patricktown Plantation; thence running South 82 1/2 degrees West 40 rods; South 53 degrees West 52 rods; North 78 degrees West 31 rods; North 65 degrees West 57 rods; North 78 1/2 degrees West 37 rods; North 84 degrees West 110 rods; North 50 degrees West 28 rods; North 74 1/2 degrees West 69 rods; North 84 1/2 degrees West 44 rods; South 59 degrees West 28 rods; North 87 1/2 degrees West 60 rods; North 69 degrees West 127 rods to the southeast corner of Haskell's Fulling Mill, North 65 degrees West 372 rods to the southwest corner of Batchelder's Store North 66 degrees West 180 rods; South 79 degrees West 105 rods to Trouant Corner, North 66 degrees West 100 rods; North 80 degrees West 198 rods; South 73 1/2 degrees West 100 rods; South 87 1/2 degrees West 72 rods; South 85 degrees West 71 rods; South 70 1/2 degrees West 55 rods; South 53 degrees West 27 rods; South 63 3/4 degrees West 110 rods to a stone monument marked "R" on the margin of a small brook; South 63 degrees West 75 rods to a stone marked "R" in the field north of Sedgley house, South 63 degrees West (same course) 170 rods; South 43 degrees West 55 rods; South 53 degrees West 88 rods; South 63 degrees West 20 rods; South 48 degrees West 36 rods; South 25 degrees West 40 rods; South 42 1/2 degrees West 124 rods; South 62 degrees West 70 rods; South 50 degrees West 84 rods; South 71 degrees West 40 rods; South 68 degrees West 21 rods; South 77 degrees West 44 rods; North 68 degrees West 70 rods; North 78 degrees West 60 rods to a stone monument marked "R" standing 4 rods northwardly from a stone at the north end of the road leading to Pittston, which was laid out in 1831. Stone monuments at each angle of the above described line and said line is the north line of the road, and said road is 4 rods.
