The Committee to whom was referred the petition of E. Robinson and others for a new street leading from Bridge Street to the City Farm have had that subject under consideration and would report, that in conformity with a notice posted up on the 25th day of November 1850 in two public places in the City in the vicinity of the proposed street of the intention of the City Council to layout the same on the 2nd day of November at 8 o'clock a.m. at the School House on North Street, so-called in said City. Your committee we assembled at the time and place mentioned in said notice and proceeded to the location of the said proposed street and laid out the same as follows, viz:

Beginning on the north side of Bridge Street on the west side of the Kennebec River and at the southeast corner of Davis Guild's lot at a bound; thence North 20 degrees 30' East 54 rods

to a bound; thence North 9 degrees East 12 rods and 9 feet; thence North 20 degrees 45' West 9 rods and 14 feet to a bound on the south line of the City Farm. The street so located to be forty feet wide and east of bounds and courses.
