Sprague Manufacturing Company, in behalf of said Company, hereby represents that for the accommodation of the new Mill and other buildings, it would be a great accommodation to said Company, to be allowed the use of a portion of Northern Avenue sixteen feet in width on the northwesterly side thereof from Water Street, to a point opposite the north westerly and of their lower boarding house, and hereby request that leave may be granted said Company, to use the same upon condition that said Company shall build and maintain a suitable wall upon said line, and also a good and sufficient railing upon the same when necessary.

The Joint Standing Committee on Highways to whom was referred the petition of Wm. H. Furbush and others for fixing the line of Northern Avenue & C. & C.

Report

That we have been furnished by the City Engineer with a copy of the record of the location of Northern Avenue so far as it relates to the property bounded thereon on the Northeasterly side thereof, by which it appears that the road was established as a county road at the April Term of the Court 1839, and the only encroachment thereon is by the fence in front of the Hyatt Miner lot. The line as near as can be ascertained and run by the City Engineer commences at a mark on the fence just three feet easterly from the Northwest corner of the fence and runs South about 20 degrees East to the center of the Northwest corner post of the lot owned or occupied by Thomas Baker. The way leading by the east side of said Baker's lot is a private passageway called on the City Map, "Jefferson Place" and therefore does not require any action on the part of the City. The road passing Northerly from the old Zechariah Furbush Corner which passes by the Grady lots being a very old location if important or necessary to know about would require much investigation or perhaps a new location by the County Com'rs. After a careful consideration of these facts we recommend the passage of the accompanying order.
