**READ AND PASSED**

99 ORDERED, That a Portion of Old Belgrade Road, description below, be discontinued.

That section of the highway as shown on a Maine Department of Transportation Right-of-Way Map entitled "State Highway "G", Augusta, Kennebec County, Federal Aid Project F-0131-1 (3)" dated March 1953, on file in the Office of the Maine Department of Transportation, at its office in Augusta, File No. 6-59 and being more fully described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the present northeasterly boundary line of "Old Belgrade Road" about one hundred thirteen (113) feet easterly from and as measured along a line normal to the Route 27 Base Line (as established in 1953) at Station 215 + 65;

Thence northwesterly by a direct course about seventy-eight (78) feet to a point about sixty-five (65) feet easterly from and as measured along a line normal to the Route 27 Base Line at Station 216 + 25, said point being on the center line of "Old Belgrade Road";

Thence northwesterly along the center line of "Old Belgrade Road" about seventy-eight (78) feet to a point fifty (50) feet easterly from and as measured along a line normal to the Route 27 Base Line at about Station 216 + 98;

Thence northerly by a curved line fifty (50) feet easterly on and concentric with a 2 degree 20 minute 00 second curve of the Route 27 Base Line about two hundred twenty-two (222) feet to a point fifty (50) feet easterly of the Route 27 Base Line at about Station 219 + 16, said point being on the northeasterly boundary line of "Old Belgrade Road" now Route 27;

Thence southeasterly along the northeasterly boundary line of "Old Belgrade Road" about three hundred sixty-seven (367) feet to point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, That the City of Augusta not retain a public easement over the herein described discontinued area, as provided in Title 23 M.R.S.A. Section 3026.

**Deed Description**

**OLD BELGRADE ROAD**

Know All Men by These Presents,

That it, St. Augustine's Federal Credit Union, a corporation established by law and having its place of business in Augusta, in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine, by its officer hereunto authorized,

in consideration of one dollar and other valuable considerations,

paid by the City of Augusta, a body politic and corporate organized and existing under the laws of the State of Maine and having an office in said Augusta,

the receipt whereof it does hereby acknowledge, does hereby remise, release, bargain, sell and convey, and forever quit-claim unto the said City of Augusta, its successors

and assigns forever, all its right, title and interest in an to a certain lot or parcel of land, situated in said Augusta, at the intersection of the West River Road and the Old Belgrade Road, said lot or parcel of land being bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin located on the easterly side of the Old Belgrade Road approximately 36.5 feet northerly of the point which marks the intersection between the Old Belgrade Road and the West River Road; thence running South 11 degrees 45 minutes East, 36.5 feet along the easterly boundary of the Old Belgrade Road to a point which marks the intersection between the Old Belgrade Road and the West River Road; thence turning and running North 41 degrees 4 minutes East, 36.5 feet along the westerly side of the West River Road to an iron pin; thence turning and running 32.5 feet to the point of beginning.

The purpose of this deed is to convey to the City of Augusta all its interest in the above described property, which property is presently being used, or will be in the future, for street purposes.
