The undersigned inhabitants of said City hereby represent the street next west of Sewall Street leading southerly from Capitol Street to land of Daniel T. Pike called Page Street has not been laid out and accepted as a public street we therefore request that the same may be laid out by the City and accepted of same width as laid out by the original owners being forty feet.

The Joint Standing Committee on New Streets to whom was referred the Petition of S. A. Thurston and others for a new street and upon which notice ordered on the 6th day of October 1877. Report that in accordance with said petition and the order of notice which was duly given as appears by the original notice of the City Clerk and return of the City Marshall thereon herewith returned. Your committee met at the time and place named in said notice to wit at the house of Stephen A.Thurston on the 22nd day of October 1877 at 2 o'clock P.M. and laid out a street as prayed for in said petition as follows:

Bounds and Admeasurements

Commencing in the south line of Capitol Street at the northeast corner of lot numbered 32, thirty-two, on a plan of land west of the State House formerly known as the Page Field, which plan is on file in the office of the Register of Deeds for Kennebec County; thence running South $27 \frac{3}{4}$ degrees West passing over several stone monuments lot in the ground on the easterly line of seven lots represented on said plan five hundred and ninety-four feet and eight inches to a stone bound at the southeast corner of lot numbered 25, twenty-five, in the north line of land of Daniel T. Pike said street to be forty feet wide and on the easterly side of said line said street is represented on the plan aforesaid and was laid out by the owners for the

accommodations of the lots bounded thereon therefore no damages are awarded to any person and none were claimed said street to be hereafter known as Page Street it appearing on said plan in pencil as White Street.

The bounds and admeasurements thereof we have filed with the City Clerk seven days prior to the date hereof as provided by the City Ordinance in relation to the location of new streets.
